



ETG PROFICIENCY TEST 2009

The University Center of Legal Medicine Geneva-Lausanne on behalf of the Society of Hair Testing is organizing the second ethyl glucuronide (EtG) proficiency test.

The hair samples come from real autopsy cases and cover a concentration range representative for our daily routine work. The hair was washed with water and acetone, cut roughly and then powdered. The homogeneity of the powdered hair samples was tested at three different days in quadruplicates. With respect to the different lab equipment, each laboratory can work with its own analytical method. Nevertheless, we recommend to extract (incubate) the hair in the same manner as (1 ml water, 2 hours ultrasonic incubation). The purification step as well as the analytical measurement are in the responsibility of each lab.

The laboratories will receive a certificate to corroborate their successful participation.
